You can explore the region by bicycle on the cycle path, or go there by boat. You can also discover the region in the course of a day or spend an entire holiday there. This hinterland has many attractions and is quite affordable. You can discover the Entre-deux-Mers with your family, as a couple, or with friends, and the region facilitates visits by the disabled. The warm welcome visitors receive goes hand in hand with the ease with which they can visit the region at their own rhythm.

Entre-deux-Mers crossroads of major cycling routes

THE CANAL DES 2 MERS A VELO

It connects the Atlantic to the Mediterranean over 750 km from Royan to Sète, via Bordeaux, the Canal de Garonne, Toulouse and the Canal du Midi. In Entre-deux-Mers, this route follows:

The Roger Lapébie track: green track built on an old railway, the cycle path about 60 km long allows to connect Bordeaux to Sauveterre-de-Guyenne. It offers a hilly route, a tunnel, and a wide variety of landscapes

The road bike Sauveterre - La Réole, is marked out and allows you to connect the canal's green road by taking small quiet roads.

The canal greenway: it was built on the towpath of the Garonne canal. The course, partly shaded under large plane trees, is pleasant and close to the Garonne river.



A CYCLING CULTURE AND REAL ASSETS

ACCUEIL VELO

The bicycle has been developed for 20 years in Entre-deux-Mers. The region has a real cycling culture and undeniable assets for practicing this gentle activity. Several possibilities are available to tourists, take the Lapébie track and enjoy refreshing stops in the old converted train stations, pedal along the shaded green channel of the canal but also travel along the small quiet roads of the Bordeaux hinterland, suitable for cycling.

Discover the most beautiful views of the Gironde on the vineyard and on the river, enjoy authentic encounters, taste the wines of our appellations and be charmed by its heritage, this is what Entredeux-Mers offers!

THE SCANDIBERIQUE

The Scandibérique is the french part of Eurovéloroute 3 (of the Pilgrims) linking Trondheim in Norway to Santiago de Compostela in Spain. In Gironde, the 180 km route crosses the Libournais, Entre-deux-Mers, Bordeaux and Sud Gironde before reaching the departments of Lot-et-Garonne and Landes.

Escapade by E-bike from Bordeaux The Entre-deux-Mers: the vineyard at your fingertips!

From the quays of Bordeaux, take the cycle path to a small road winding along the Garonne. This will take you to Latresne and the junction with the Roger Lapébie greenway. You have arrived in the heart of the Entredeux-Mers!

Cycle along the greenway built on an old railway line, it offers refreshing stops in the restored old stations (bars, second-hand shops, tourist stops...) crosses varied landscapes (vines, woods...) and the pretty bastide of Créon.

To eat, there's nothing like a good country picnic in the heart of the vineyards. Comfortably seated, enjoy a tasting basket of local products in the park of the Château le Grand Verdus estate.

On the way back, you will come across the Abbey of La Sauve Majeure: a masterpiece of 12th century Romanesque art, this historical monument bears witness to religious architecture that has spanned the centuries. Welcome to this enchanting site, out of time!


You will then head towards the Garonne by taking country roads suitable for cycle touring and leading to beautiful wine-growing landscapes: small hillsides on one side and rows of vines plunging down to the Garonne on the other. At the bend in the road, the majestic medieval castle of Langoiran dominates the Garonne valley.

Between Langoiran, on the banks of the Garonne, and Créon, take a majestic avenue to arrive at the Château Lamothe de Haux. This residence with its typical regional architecture, whose foundations date back to the 16th century, has a very singular particularity: cellars built in impressive galleries dug in the 17th and 18th centuries. Fossils of sea urchins and oysters bear witness to the presence of the sea on this limestone plateau long ago. You can also observe mammoth bones and traces of troglodyte habitation. A real journey through time!

It's time to announce our last stop. Located on the heights of the Garonne, the Cabane dans les vignes is the ideal spot to end this beautiful escapade. On the menu, tapas made with local products and a breathtaking sunset!

The Dolce Vita 30 minutes from Bordeaux!

Day 1 : city of art and history and rural paths Départure from Bordeaux by train up to La Réole

You will reach the city of art and history by train. From the train station, get on your bike and explore the thousand-year-old city. The streets lined with half-timbered houses will lead you to the oldest town hall in France. The Terra Aventura route will take you to discover its small streets, the 13th century St-Pierre church as well as the esplanade which adjoins the former Benedictine abbey offering a beautiful view of the Garonne valley.

On the Canal des 2 Mers cycle route, you will take quiet country roads suitable for cycling. In an ocean of vines, this route with a slightly marked relief, joins the bastide of Sauveterre-de-Guyenne. You will be welcomed in bed and breakfast accommodation, in the heart of a wine estate.

Picnic baskets, energetic breakfasts, dinner at the hosts' table and food and wine pairings with a winemaker who will join you to animate your meal, our partners will go all out and will be at your disposal to offer you a successful stay!

Day 2: Journey between vineyards, forest and bastide.

To start this day, along the trail, you will live a unique experience by taking the tunnel of La Sauve. Wood, vineyards, the bucolic landscapes of the Bordeaux hinterland are available to you before entering the small bastide town of Sauveterre-de-Guyenne.





The wine routes: 10 itineraries on foot, by bike, by car...

N °1 : ROUTE DES BORDEAUX EN BORD DE DORDOGNE (43 km - 1 h)

After a picturesque discovery and tasting, you can leave the Bordeaux Wine House to discover our vineyards and villages.

N°2: ROUTE DES BÂTISSEURS (145 km - 3 h)

From the bastides to the abbevs and the fortified grain mills, follow this road that will reveal the history of the men who really built the Entre-deux-Mers.

N°3: CHEMIN JACQUAIRE, SUR LA VOIE DE VÉZELAY (23 km - 30 mn)

Take the Vézelay Road, the pilgrims' route of Saint-Jacques, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, to discover our vineyards and the people who shape them.

N°4: COTEAUX EN ÉGLISES ROMANES (32 km - 40 mn)

To discover the hillsides of the Garonne, admire our Romanesque churches, the Malromé castle, family house of Toulouse-Lautrec and make a stop in our wineries. The views and the decoration changeable will be the dessert of this adventure.

N°5 : ROUTE PANORAMIQUE DES CÔTEAUX DE GARONNE (30 km - 40 mn)

This itinerary will allow you to discover the Côtes-de-Bordeaux Saint-Macaire appellation, sweet and liquorous white wines with aromas of honey, acacia, citrus, vanilla and apricot and beautiful views of the Garonne valley.

N°6: ROUTE DES TERROIRS, PASSION D'OR (46 km - 50 mn)

Between heritage and vineyards, discover the richness of the territory and its controlled appellations of origin: Cadillac Côtes de Bordeaux rouge, and the sweet wines: AOC Cadillac - Côtes de- Bordeaux Saint-Macaire -Loupiac - Premières Côtes-de-Bordeaux - Sainte-Croix du Mont.

N°7: ROUTE DES SEIGNEURS (56 km - 1 h)

Beautiful landscapes to explore around Langoiran to discover the slopes of the Appellations d'Origine Controlled: Cadillac Côtes de Bordeaux rouge, and the sweet wines: AOC Cadillac - Premières Cotes de Bordeaux.

N°8 : ROUTE ENTRE SEIGNEURS CHÂTELAINS (48 km - 45 mn)

appellation. The name comes from the Viscount of Benauge, where the remains of a powerful castle of Arbis remain. This designation of strong, vivid and balanced sweet whites also produces some dry white wines close to those of Entredeux-Mers.

N°9: ROUTE DES COTEAUX DE BORDEAUX (51 km-50 mn)

From Latresne you can enjoy stunning views of the Garonne River, between woods, Chartreuse and vineyards. Discover the AOC: Cadillac Côtes de Bordeaux rouge, and the sweet wines: Cadillac - Premières Cotes de Bordeaux.

CHÂTEAUX N°10 : ROUTE DES ETVIGNOBLES AUX PORTES DE BORDEAUX (70 km - 1h15)

At the gates of Bordeaux, between the Dordogne and the Garonne rivers, discover this semi-rural territory characterized by viticulture.



AGRIÉNERGIE OR HOW TO TRANSFORM OUR WASTE INTO ENERGY.

The Auros Methanization Plant is open for visits.

The company Agriénergie, which consists of a collective of nine farmers, aims to diversify their activities by treating livestock effluents to address the challenges of energy transition. This methanization unit currently produces green gas based on livestock effluents, energy crops, as well as waste from fruits and vegetables, and grape marc from a local supermarket and cooperative.

This local project has brought together public and private stakeholders around the founding farmers. Methanization not only helps to sustain the economic model of a farm, but also contributes positively to the local area through its environmental and economic benefits.

During the visit, there will be explanations and demonstrations organized into three parts: Welcome and presentation of the team and the working unit, a guided tour to explain the theoretical functioning of the company, and a site visit to observe the process of agricultural effluents being transformed into gas.



he wandering Heritage Trails...

The patina of centuries

The Entre-deux-Mers has managed to preserve the memory of stones. Its monuments tell a story embellished by the centuries. This prestigious past is reflected in the imposing architecture of the ducal castle overlooking the ramparts of Cadillac, the neoclassical nobility of the Benedictine priory of La Réole, or the charming medieval city of Rions. It is discovered, miraculously preserved, in the mosaics of a Gallo-Roman villa near Loupiac or on the sculpted capitals of the Abbey of La Sauve-Majeure. If there is a living heritage, it is certainly that of the bastides. Walking through them is to admire the genius of the builders of the medieval age who invented a new city within their walls in the West.

Explore the Bordeaux hinterland and discover its prestigious past.





ABBAYE DE LA SAUVE

World Heritage Site UNESCO

Founded in 1079, this masterpiece of Romanesque art is listed by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site under the title of the routes of Santiago de Compostela. The majestic ensemble that remains today offers a timeless landscape, in an open-air site, with exceptional sculptures and vestiges in a haven of tranquility, a magnificent testimony of religious architecture at the heart of the Entredeux-Mers.

MEDIEVAL VILLAGES

La Réole, city of Art and History

The thousand-year-old city of Entre-deux-Mers offers a very rich monumental ensemble, from the Middle Ages to the 19th century, highlighted by the Garonne River. It was around the Benedictine abbey that the city was built, which took the name of Régula, La Réole today, where the monks of the priory followed the rule of Saint Benedict.

Let yourself be guided in the city of Richard the Lionheart. The narrow streets lined with half-timbered houses will lead you to the oldest town hall in France. You will then discover the church of Saint-Pierre, the Benedictine abbey and the elegant arabesques of the listed wrought ironwork (18th century).

Castelmoron d'Albret

Built on a limestone rock overlooking the Ségur valley, Castelmoron d'Albret is the smallest commune in France. As you stroll through its steep streets lined with old houses, its walls and the mill gate will imbue you with its history.

THE BASTIDES

Remnants of medieval life, these fortified villages are characterised by their construction around an arcaded square. The bastides of the Entre-deux-Mers region were all founded in the 13th and 14th centuries, and are well worth a visit, as each has its own special character: the bastide of Créon with its magnificent arcaded square, the bastide of Monségur: the only bastide on a hilltop in the Gironde, overlooking the Dropt. Then there's Sauveterre-de-Guyenne with its four walled gates, Blasimon with its Benedictine abbey, and finally the bastide town of Cadillac, surrounded by its walls and bordered by the Château.

CADILLAC CASTLE

Overlooking the Garonne River and the bastide town of Cadillac, the château is a typical example of a 17th-century stately home, and has preserved its original decor (monumental fireplaces, tapestries, painted ceilings). In the 19th century, the residence was converted into a women's prison.

Notre Dame de Bonnenouvelle and the Blasimon menhir.

In the heart of the Entre-deux-Mers region, the rolling valleys take you on a journey through time. Here, the chapel of Bonne Nouvelle tells of a time when magic and diverse beliefs rubbed shoulders with the first Christian sites. A miraculous ferruginous fountain existed nearby. People came from far and wide because it cured all illnesses! These sites have been occupied by man since prehistoric times: the Cluzet cave, used from the Neolithic period until the Middle Ages. The Forêt cave, the dolmen or covered walkway, the menhirs at Bois du Luc or Vallée de Sainte-Catherine and the Bonne Nouvelle menhir. This menhir, in the immediate vicinity of the Chapelle de Bonne-Nouvelle, is a vestige of a megalithic alignment reported in 1886 by Léo Drouyn. It is now only 1.45 m high, whereas it was once 2.50 m high and 1 m wide.

The Commanderie of Pondaurat

What an adorable little village this is! Bathed by the Bassanne river, the hamlet has been welcoming pilgrims on their way to Santiago de Compostela for centuries. The Antonines settled here to found a hospitable commandery, which went through a number of vicissitudes. Nevertheless, it was the source of major economic development from the 13th century onwards. Evidence of this can be seen in the mills and the "pont-digue" bridge that gives the town its name.

Constructed of pretty golden stone, this medieval "golden bridge" delights with its warm colours. Formerly fortified, the commandery now shelters passing pilgrims, as it did in the past. The picturesque setting is bathed in beautiful light at the end of the day, revealing itself in all its glory.

The Château de Benauge

Château de Benauge is one of the largest medieval fortresses in the department. Situated on the highest point of the Entre-deux-Mers region of Bordeaux, it was the seat of a powerful seigneury from the end of the 11th century. It was besieged by the King of England in 1253 and then rebuilt by the Grailly family, who also built the neighbouring bastide town of Cadillac. In 1453, it witnessed one of the last battles of the Hundred Years' War during a new siege, this time led by Charles VII, King of France. Benauge passed into the hands of the Duc d'Epernon, who relegated it to the background when he built the imposing ducal palace of Cadillac in the early 17th century. Today, the towering silhouette of the romantic ruins of Benauge stands out against the rolling landscape of the Entre-deux-Mers region. Privately owned, the château is open to group visits by prior arrangement.
